**Revised Guidelines for filling up the **Generic Elective (GE)** Form for  
Semester II (All Honors Courses), UGCF, Academic 2022-23**

**Dated: 20-03-2023**

**There were some technical glitches in the form provided earlier, due to which data could not be extracted. So, all the students who have filled the form earlier are requested to fill the option form again.**

With reference to the choosing of Generic Elective of 2022-23 session (Even semester, Semester-II), you are requested to fill this online option form through Google form by Wednesday, **Dated 22.03.2023**, failing which it would be presumed that the student doesn't want to exercise his/her options as such and is comfortable with the allocation of any paper, given by the college. In that case, the GE Coordination Committee of the college may allocate whatever possible paper to the student based on the committee discretion.

Generic Elective (GE) is an elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek exposure to other discipline/subject. The Generic Elective has equal credit as that of core paper. Students need to read the instructions carefully and abide by them:

1. It is **mandatory for all the students of all Hons. courses of Semester-II** to fill this option form, choosing the GE/Interdisciplinary course they want to opt for the 2022-23 session (Even semester, Semester-II).
2. The students are required to give **three preferences** of the GE/Interdisciplinary course offered by the different departments for the Semester-II of session 2022-23. **The College will allot the GE subject on first come first serve basis. Students should follow extreme care while filling up the google form. Students are not allowed to change their GE subjects at a later stage.**
3. The students of only Semester-II of All Hons. courses need to opt the subject of their interest **offered by the other departments** i.e., If a student is in Semester-II of B.Com (H) than the student will choose a GE subject of his/her interest from **Non-Commerce Department only and Vice Versa. The students cannot choose the course offered by their own department.**  
**For Example: A Student pursuing B.Com (H) cannot opt the GE/ Interdisciplinary course offered by the Commerce Department of the College.**
4. Students need to choose their option only from the respective segment defined for their core department i.e. students of B.A. Economics (H) Sem-II will choose their GE option from the section **"Options only for the students of B.A. Economics (Hons.), Semester-II, Department of Economics"**.

5. Please note that students who wants to study the paper **Communication in management** Offered by the Department of Commerce, **must have studied** the paper **Business Organisation as GE in Semester I**.  
And students who wants to study the paper **Delhi Through the Ages :From colonial to Contemporary Times**- Offered by the Department of History, **must have studied** the paper **Delhi through the Ages: The Making of its Early Modern History as GE in Semester I**.
