INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. The test is scheduled for Sunday, the 28th January, 2018. The candidates are required to be present at 09:30 a.m. The test would commence at 10:00 a.m.
2. Candidates are required to carry a valid Photo ID Card issued by Govt. Authority, viz. Aadhaar Card, Driving License, Voter ID Card, Passport etc.
3. **If a candidate do not receive the admit card by 23rd January, 2018, he/she may get the duplicate copy of the admit card from the office on 24-25 January, 2018.**
4. The minimum overall qualifying marks for the written test shall be 45% for the unreserved posts and 40% for the posts reserved for OBC category and 35% for the posts reserved for SC/ST/PwD category.
However, section (ii), (iii), (iv) & (v) of the paper-I will be evaluated only if a candidate obtains 50% marks in the section (i) of the paper-I, 5% relaxation will be provided for SC/ST/OBC/PwD.
4. There shall be **negative marking for wrong answers in written test to the tune of 1/4th of marks allocated per question.**
5. Merit shall be drawn only for candidates who qualify written test.
6. Use only Blue/Black Pen for darkening the appropriate circles in the OMR/ answer sheet.
7. Rough work for Paper is to be done in the given space on the Test Booklet and not on the OMR/answer sheet.
8. Make sure that you do not possess any page (Blank / Handwritten /Printed) of any unauthorized material, mobile phone/ cellular phone / cordless phone / or any type of communication device / scanner etc. If such material is found in your possession during examination, you will be disqualified and would be liable for appropriate legal action.
9. At the end of examination, handover the answer sheet/ OMR Sheet to the invigilator. You may carry the test booklet along with you.
10. Do not leave the examination hall until you are asked to do so.
11. After the examination the answer key shall be uploaded on the College website www.sbsc.in. In case you have any objection in regard to any answer, you may submit the same within 07 days from the date of test paper. Please further note that no objection correspondence/representation shall be entertained thereafter.


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
